

PREVENTION

Prevention Is The Best Medicine

Blue Springs Animal Hospital monitors local risks for contagious diseases and parasites and makes recommendations to protect pets in our area, while avoiding over-vaccination.

- » **Canine DHPP, Feline DRCP:** Diseases which cause serious illness or death. Administered at sequential ages with the final series booster at 4-6 months of age. Boostered again in 1 year, then every 2-3 years.
- » **Canine Leptospirosis:** Deadly disease which is contagious to people as well as dogs. Administered twice during the puppy series and repeated yearly.
- » **Canine Bordetella:** Contagious respiratory infection. Given once in the puppy series with boosters every 6 mos. Separated from the DHPP to reduce immune stress.
- » **Canine Influenza Virus:** Contagious respiratory infection which causes serious pneumonia in 20% of infected dogs. Given twice in the puppy series with boosters yearly.
- » **Feline Leukemia:** Virus which attacks the immune system and may be associated with cancer. Given twice to kittens, repeated in 6 mos, then yearly. Separated from the DRCP to reduce immune stress.
- » **Rabies:** Administered once to puppies or kittens and repeated every 1-3 years.
- » **Intestinal Parasites:** Most puppies and kittens have parasites. An initial deworming targets Rounds and Hooks which may be too immature to shed the eggs seen on a fecal test. Fecal tests detect other parasites which may not appear until older ages. Fecal tests should be repeated 3-4 times during the puppy series and every 6-12 months thereafter.
- » **Heartworms:** Deadly parasites spread by mosquitos which infect the heart of dogs and cats. Prevention is needed in this area year around.

** Other vaccines such as Lyme vaccine may be recommended depending on exposure.

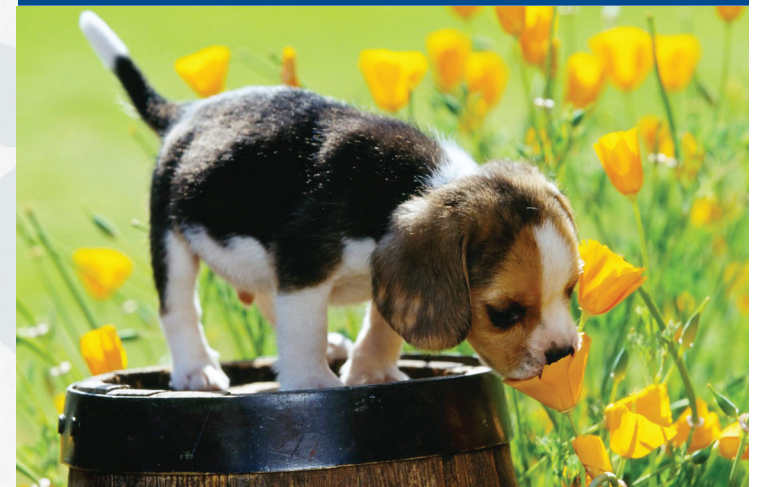
